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GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

Luke 14:1, 7-14

Once I was invited to a group meeting with Pope Francis. Entering the room, I paused, eyeing the seats next to the Pope's fancy chair. Someone saw my paralysis and invited me to sit in the seat farthest from what I wanted. Hiding my disappointment, I sat. We waited. To our surprise, an aid pointed out that those seats were still empty and invited me and another to have them. We calmly but gleefully strode across the room and sat. Pope Francis entered, and we enjoyed two hours of amazingly uplifting conversation.

Jesus says this week to us: **"When you are invited, go and take the lowest place so that when the host comes to you he may say, 'My friend, move up to a higher position.' Then you will enjoy the esteem of your companions at the table"** (Luke 14:10). This is not about how to score free seat upgrades. Rather, it is a wise pattern for the whole of life. It is how to live free from the anxiety of constantly grasping for status and recognition.

Jesus perfectly embodies his seat-taking advice. He eschews his glorious throne for the lowest: death on a cross, that lonely chair we all deserve. In his resurrection, he calls us up higher to his marvelous banquet seats. This week, perhaps we should look for opportunities to choose the lowest seat. We'll be pleasantly surprised when we do.

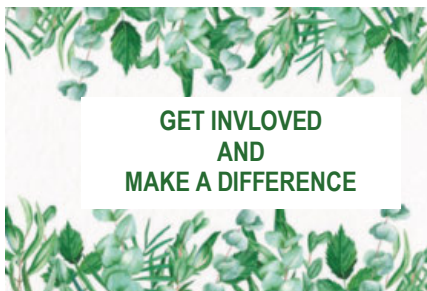

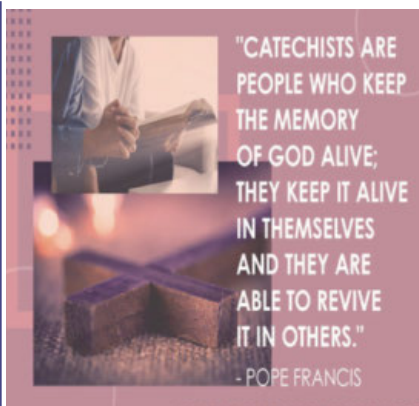

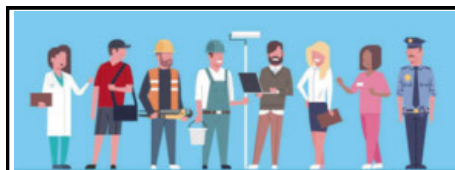

Question and Answer

Parish Registration

Question:

Why is it so important that we register in a parish? Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?

Answer:

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times, young adults who have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Your registration affects the parish in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many priests are assigned to a church, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how Masses, Confessions, and devotions are planned and scheduled.

Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.

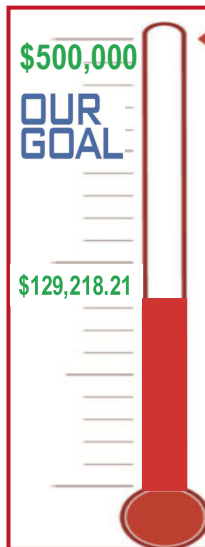

Registro Parroquial****Pregunta:**

¿Por qué es tan importante que nos inscribamos en una parroquia? ¿No es suficiente que vayamos a Misa?

Respuesta:

La inscripción es la forma oficial en que nos unimos a una comunidad parroquial. Muchas personas piensan que, porque asisten a una parroquia en particular, automáticamente pertenecen. A veces, los adultos jóvenes que se han mudado durante años piensan que todavía están inscritos bajo la tutela de sus padres. Pero la membresía requiere inscribirse, registrarse formalmente en una parroquia. La inscripción es un compromiso con una comunidad, una forma de ser incluido en las actividades religiosas, sociales y ministeriales de tu parroquia. Tu registro afecta a la parroquia de muchas maneras. Los números del censo pueden determinar cuántos sacerdotes están asignados a una iglesia, qué beneficios y obligaciones tiene la comunidad para con la diócesis, y cómo se planifican y programan las misas, confesiones y devociones.

El registro muestra que perteneces. También es necesario para ciertos beneficios, como programar los sacramentos, obtener certificados de patrocinador y obtener estados de cuenta de donaciones para los impuestos. Lo más importante es que permite que la parroquia cuente contigo, que te llame para que ayudes en su misión. Registrarte en tu parroquia es una declaración de fe y confianza en la vida y el trabajo de tu parroquia.
