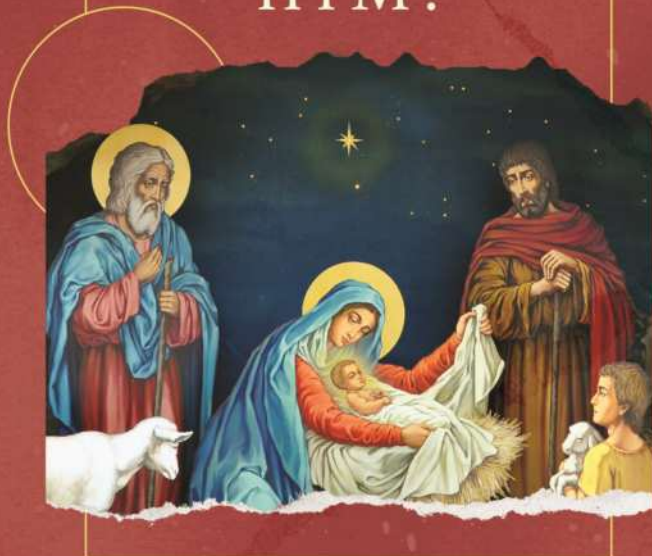

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GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER
UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

December 21, 2025 - Fourth Sunday of Advent
Matthew 1:18-24

A priest friend recently told me a remarkable story. One of his cousins reported having a vivid dream in which an angel told him the family needed to exhume their grandmother's body from a cemetery in New York and return it to her birthplace in Romania. She had been dead nearly ten years. As you might expect, the family thought it was, well, crazy. But astonishingly they exhumed her body. It was incorrupt, showing no signs of decomposition. That experience sparked healing, faith, and reconciliation throughout the family.

In this Sunday's Gospel, Joseph also receives a dream. He's confused, afraid. But in the quiet of sleep, God speaks: **"Do not be afraid to take Mary your wife into your home" (Matthew 1:20).** When he wakes, Joseph acts. He doesn't overanalyze or dismiss the message. He trusts, and acts.

God still speaks — not necessarily through literal dreams but through those deeper intuitions of the heart. St. Ignatius of Loyola taught that God's voice draws us into peace, courage, and love. But we have to listen to it. Advent is a time for stillness. As we prepare for Christ's coming, we're invited to enter that quiet space where God's voice can be heard.

When and how do you become most receptive to God? Is it in silence? In prayer? In nature? At Mass? This week, go there. Be still. Listen. And like Joseph, have the courage to act on what God shows you.

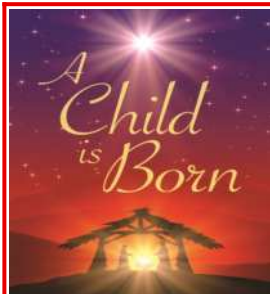

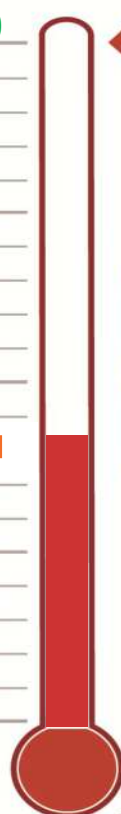

GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE
DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF
SCRIPTURE

Fourth Sunday of Advent
Matthew 1:18-24

On this last Sunday of Advent, Emmanuel, God with us, is about to be born. This is the Good News that should fill us with joy: understanding that the birth of Jesus is the guarantee that God fulfills his promise with the arrival of his Son into the world. The Gospel gives us the opportunity to contemplate the unfolding of salvation history in humanity. God mingles with us, uniting himself with our triumphs and failures. There is nothing left to fear: Jesus comes to illuminate our darkness. "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call him Emmanuel, which means, 'God with us'" (Matthew 1:23).

Today's liturgy also allows us to admire Joseph, the husband of the Virgin Mary, and to learn from his courage, his ability to remain silent, and his conduct toward her. Joseph made the difficult decision, amidst his circumstances, not to defame Mary and to divorce her quietly. Protecting her and the child was his priority. "You are to name the son she will bear. You will call him Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins" (Matthew 1:21). Thanks to Joseph's prudence and righteous silence, Jesus was able to be born of Mary. How prudent am I in the face of the events I experience in my life? Do I know how to keep secrets so as not to harm others? Have I set aside moments of silence during this Advent to help me grow spiritually?

IV Domingo de Adviento
Mateo 1:18-24

En este último domingo de Adviento, Emmanuel, Dios con nosotros, está por nacer. Esta es la Buena Noticia que debe alegrarnos: comprender que el nacimiento de Jesús es la garantía de que Dios cumple su promesa con la llegada de su Hijo al mundo. El Evangelio nos da la oportunidad de contemplar el paso de la historia de la salvación en la humanidad. Dios se mezcla entre nosotros, se une a nuestros triunfos y fracasos. Ya no hay nada que temer: Jesús llega para iluminar nuestras tinieblas. *"La virgen concebirá y dará a luz un hijo, y le pondrán por nombre Emmanuel, que significa: Dios con nosotros"* (Mateo 1:23).

También la liturgia de hoy nos permite admirar a José, esposo de la Virgen, y tomar ejemplo de su valor, de su capacidad para guardar silencio y de su forma de actuar ante ella. José tomó la difícil decisión, en medio de la situación que vivía, de no difamar a María y repudiarla en secreto. Protegerla a ella y al niño fue su prioridad. *"Tú eres el que pondrás el nombre al hijo que ella dará a luz. Y lo llamarás Jesús, porque él salvará a su pueblo de sus pecados"* (Mateo 1:21). Gracias a esa prudencia y justo silencio de José, Jesús pudo nacer de María. ¿Cómo es mi prudencia ante los acontecimientos que atravieso en mi vida? ¿Sé guardar secretos para no destruir la vida de los demás? ¿He guardado espacios de silencio en este Adviento que me ayuden a mi crecimiento espiritual?
