**GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE**

**John 11:1-45**

Lent is almost over; one more Sunday and we will be celebrating Palm Sunday. Forty days of preparation for Easter are about to conclude. We have accompanied Jesus through the temptations in the desert; then we went with Him to the Mount of Transfiguration; we went to Jacob's well with the Samaritan woman and found the Living Water; we arrived at the Pool of Siloam and were healed of our blindness. And today, we celebrate the Sunday on which we will rise again with Lazarus. The resurrection of Lazarus is a triumph over death. But before this miracle, Martha, Lazarus's sister, goes to meet Jesus, and in their conversation, He tells her: "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die" (John 11:26). Jesus asks us today the same question He asked Martha: "Do you believe this?" What is your answer? Have you experienced any change in your heart during this Lent?

If our faith is mature, we will live as resurrected people from this moment on, not only at the end of our lives. Let us, therefore, give Jesus a profound and committed response, both to ourselves and to those around us. Let us respond like Martha and Peter: "Yes, Lord, I believe." Lord, help us to be part of your plan for life, to build a better world where peace reigns. We want to be witnesses of hope, where your love exists through our lives and our journey toward you. Jesus says to each of us today: "Lazarus, come out!" (John 11:43).

**Reflection: 5th Sunday of Lent**  
Are you asleep?

Today Jesus is called to the grave of a dear friend who had recently died. Martha cries out that if Jesus were closer, her brother Lazarus would not have died.

Remember from the First Sunday in Lent that death and sin are connected and that life is seen as living a faith-filled life? That is what is happening in this Gospel. Living as a disciple of Christ can give us the ability for a life everlasting in the presence of God.





**DIocese OF SAN DIEGO**

As previously announced by the Diocese in 2022, at the conclusion of a three-year visitation, the Apostolic See (*specifically the then-Congregation for Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life*) by means of a Decree dated 13 May 2022 and approved in forma specifica by Pope Francis, suppressed the religious institute formerly known as the Trinitarians of Mary. With this suppression, the former members of the Trinitarians were automatically dispensed from their vows and are no longer permitted to present themselves as religious. There is no right of appeal, and the Trinitarians have ceased to exist as a religious institute recognized by the Catholic Church.



**DIÓCESIS DE SAN DIEGO**

Tal como fue anunciado previamente por la Diócesis en 2022, al concluir una visita canónica de tres años, la Sede Apostólica (*específicamente la entonces Congregación para los Institutos de Vida Consagrada y las Sociedades de Vida Apostólica*), mediante un Decreto fechado el 13 de mayo de 2022 y aprobado en *forma specifica* por el Papa Francisco, suprimió el instituto religioso anteriormente conocido como las Trinitarias de María. Con esta supresión, las antiguas miembros de las Trinitarias quedaron automáticamente dispensadas de sus votos y ya no están autorizadas a presentarse como religiosas. No existe derecho de apelación, y las Trinitarias han dejado de existir como instituto religioso reconocido por la Iglesia Católica.
