

**GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE
DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE**
Matthew 21:1-11

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week, also known as Easter Week. Today, two Gospel readings are proclaimed at Mass: one at the entrance to the church, so that we may joyfully walk with palms in hand to meet Christ, and the other during the Liturgy of the Word: the Passion of the Lord. Pope Francis, in his Apostolic Exhortation *The Joy of the Gospel*, writes: *“True faith in the Son of God made flesh is inseparable from self-giving, belonging to the community, service, and reconciliation with the flesh of others. The Son of God, in his incarnation, invited us to a revolution of tenderness”* (EG 88). The tenderness and mercy of God are especially present during the Passion of the Lord.

Holy Week is a special time for our spiritual renewal. As baptized Christians, we are followers of Jesus and should raise the bar of our joy, for the King of Glory is about to enter our hearts. *“Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest heaven!”* (Matthew 21:9). This acclamation and supplication is what we repeat year after year on Palm Sunday. We are blessed to be able to participate in this celebration that invites us to experience the life, passion, death, and resurrection of the Lord: the glorious Easter, the center of the entire liturgical year.

Everyday Stewardship

As a Catholic, I am very grateful for the wonderful expression of the Mass. When united in this liturgical experience, we are not only present to the reality of the bread and wine becoming the real presence of Jesus, but are also connected spiritually to the institution of the Holy Eucharist at the Last Supper and to the future heavenly banquet at the end of time. During the Eucharistic Prayer, this is a time to be truly as mindful as we can to what is happening in our midst. Our effort to completely surrender ourselves to the moment is a true act of stewardship.

When we hear the Gospel reading of the passion and death of Jesus at Mass, we are also being called to give of ourselves completely to the moment and to be truly caught up in the story. We should strive to be there at the events of over two thousand years ago, but also to what the reality of those events mean for us today. To do this effectively, we need to spend more time reflecting on the dynamics of the events of Jesus' passion. Hopefully, our Lent has been fruitful and we have spent time with devotions like the Stations of the Cross. Maybe we have taken time to read Scripture slowly and deliberately, taking time to let each aspect sink into our mind and spirit. If Lent has been instead a time of too much business and not much prayer and reflection, the good news is that it is never too late.

During this Holy Week, take some time to enter into the story of the Passion. Good stewardship calls us to not only give of that which can be seen, but also that which cannot be seen. Surrender your mind, body, and spirit to Jesus. He carries his cross before you and beckons you to follow him.



While Jesus would not be crowned an earthly king, Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem has many parallels to the Messianic expectations of the Hebrew people. Before entering, Jesus requisitions a donkey from its owner. In the ancient world, kings had this right. Yet the animal that Jesus requests is rare -- a colt upon which no one else has sat yet. Yet, it's a donkey. This is no great war-charger, no magnificent animal. Jesus acts with all the authority of an earthly king, yet his kingdom is one of simplicity and peace. As the disciples throw cloaks over the donkey, the crowd spreads theirs on the road. This ancient gesture dates back to the line of kings descended from David. Not only are these physical kingly gestures, but the crowd of followers cries out in jubilation and praise. The Messiah has come to Jerusalem!</p>

DIocese OF SAN DIEGO

As previously announced by the Diocese in 2022, at the conclusion of a three-year visitation, the Apostolic See (*specifically the then-Congregation for Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life*) by means of a Decree dated 13 May 2022 and approved in forma specifica by Pope Francis, suppressed the religious institute formerly known as the Trinitarians of Mary. With this suppression, the former members of the Trinitarians were automatically dispensed from their vows and are no longer permitted to present themselves as religious. There is no right of appeal, and the Trinitarians have ceased to exist as a religious institute recognized by the Catholic Church.

DIÓCESIS DE SAN DIEGO

Tal como fue anunciado previamente por la Diócesis en 2022, al concluir una visita canónica de tres años, la Sede Apostólica (*específicamente la entonces Congregación para los Institutos de Vida Consagrada y las Sociedades de Vida Apostólica*), mediante un Decreto fechado el 13 de mayo de 2022 y aprobado en *forma specifica* por el Papa Francisco, suprimió el instituto religioso anteriormente conocido como las Trinitarias de María. Con esta supresión, las antiguas miembros de las Trinitarias quedaron automáticamente dispensadas de sus votos y ya no están autorizadas a presentarse como religiosas. No existe derecho de apelación, y las Trinitarias han dejado de existir como instituto religioso reconocido por la Iglesia Católica.
