

**GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE
DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE**

John 20:1-9

The experience of that Easter morning was, without a doubt, clear and perfect: it was a matter of seeing and believing. At dawn, very early, Mary Magdalene went to the tomb to look for the Lord; however, what a great surprise! The stone of the tomb had been rolled away. She immediately returned to tell Peter and John, and said to them, "They have taken the Lord out of the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid him" (John 20:2). What a tremendous shock for them! After seeing Jesus suffer on the cross, now he was gone. However, that was not the plan God had devised for understanding the resurrection of his Son. Those closest to Jesus—those who had walked with him, preaching, healing the sick, and performing miracles—now had to testify that Jesus had risen, that he was alive, and that he was the same one who had shared the bread with them.

The Gospel tells us: "They still did not understand the Scripture, that he must rise from the dead" (John 20:9). Christ is alive! He has truly risen: this is the cry of his disciples and of all creation, then and now. Joy and gladness should spring from the heart of every Christian. Let us rejoice in this great gift of Easter; let us be bearers of peace, not fear. Let us be heralds of hope amidst the hostility and hatred that so often paralyze God's grace in the world.



Easter

Question:

Why does the date of Easter change every year, while most other celebrations are celebrated on the same day?

Answer:

Every feast is celebrated at a certain time for a reason. Saints feast days are commonly the day of their death. While we don't know Jesus' exact birthday, we celebrate the "light of the world" around the time of winter solstice, as dark, wintry days begin to lengthen again. We have a historical clue, however, to when the Easter events occurred. We know that Jesus was crucified the day before Passover. The Jews calculated the date for Passover based on both the solar and lunar calendars. It corresponds to the first full moon after the spring equi-

nox. The early Christians maintained this connection in their celebrations of Easter on the first Sunday after the paschal full moon.

We don't re-calculate the full moon every year. As astronomy developed, so too did the forecasts of when Easter would occur in future years. The Church has created a table of calculated dates, projecting the date of Easter decades in advance. The date of Easter also determines the date of Ash Wednesday and the season of Lent, as well as the feast days following in the Easter season, including Pentecost. So these feasts move, too! This tradition may seem complicated, but it connects our Christian faith now to what has come before — our Jewish roots and the real, historical reality of Christ's suffering, death, and resurrection. ©LPi




Invitation to Bring Up the Gifts During Mass

DIocese OF SAN DIEGO


As previously announced by the Diocese in 2022, at the conclusion of a three-year visitation, the Apostolic See (*specifically the then-Congregation for Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life*) by means of a Decree dated 13 May 2022 and approved in forma specifica by Pope Francis, suppressed the religious institute formerly known as the Trinitarians of Mary. With this suppression, the former members of the Trinitarians were automatically dispensed from their vows and are no longer permitted to present themselves as religious. There is no right of appeal, and the Trinitarians have ceased to exist as a religious institute recognized by the Catholic Church.



DIÓCESIS DE SAN DIEGO

Tal como fue anunciado previamente por la Diócesis en 2022, al concluir una visita canónica de tres años, la Sede Apostólica (*específicamente la entonces Congregación para los Institutos de Vida Consagrada y las Sociedades de Vida Apostólica*), mediante un Decreto fechado el 13 de mayo de 2022 y aprobado en *forma specifica* por el Papa Francisco, suprimió el instituto religioso anteriormente conocido como las Trinitarias de María. Con esta supresión, las antiguas miembros de las Trinitarias quedaron automáticamente dispensadas de sus votos y ya no están autorizadas a presentarse como religiosas. No existe derecho de apelación, y las Trinitarias han dejado de existir como instituto religioso reconocido por la Iglesia Católica.
