**GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE
DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE**

John 20:19-31

The mystery of the Kingdom of God is communicated by the evangelizer. This great mystery is what Jesus, in his earthly life, sought to teach his disciples, and after his resurrection, he continued to teach it. Today's Gospel demonstrates this: three times he repeats the phrase so needed in our times: "Peace be with you!" (John 20:19). Jesus emphasizes the importance of peace in communicating his teaching. Pope Leo XIV mentions this in almost all his messages: "Peace is built in the heart and from the heart" and "Peace also requires practicing justice," to mention just a few phrases that help us reflect on his message. Although the phrases are short, they are profound and help us to see the Risen Lord, and thus be able to say to those closest to us, as the disciples said to Thomas: "We have seen the Lord" (John 20:25).

What do you do specifically to have peace in your heart? How do you demonstrate it at home, at work, and at school? Today we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday, which is closely linked to peace. This Sunday was instituted by Saint John Paul II in the year 2000. Since then, it reminds us that no one in the world is excluded from contributing their grain of sand to peace and demonstrating the mercy that exists in their heart, to share it with their family and with society. The courage to proclaim peace never ends. Let us, therefore, ask with faith for this gift for the world.

WHY DO WE DO THAT? -
CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

Divine Mercy Sunday

Question:

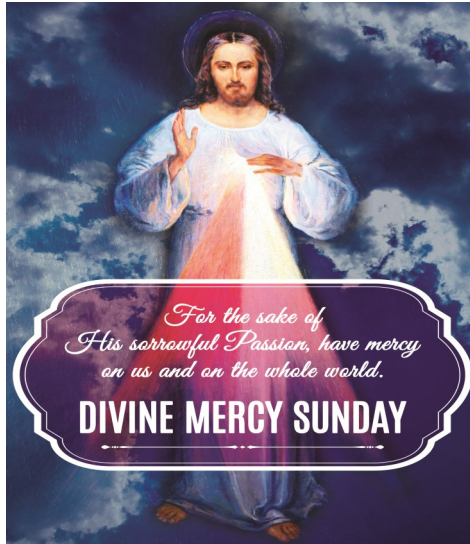
Where did the Feast of Divine Mercy come from?

Answer:

If you were born well before the year 2000, you know the Feast of Divine Mercy has not always been celebrated in the Church. In the early 1900s, a young Polish nun began receiving private revelations. Jesus appeared to her during her times of prayer, speaking a message of mercy and love for the world. She received a set of prayers — the Divine Mercy Chaplet — and the request to have a feast day established to remind the Church of the mercy of God. St. Faustina died in 1938, on the cusp of war and in the midst of one of the most violent centuries in the history of the world.

Her story and her diaries began circulating in Poland and beyond. It quickly became apparent that this was a holy young woman, and the cause for her canonization opened. In the year 2000, she was canonized by the first-ever Polish pope, St. John Paul II. On her canonization day, he established the second Sunday of Easter as Divine Mercy Sunday, “a perennial invitation to the Christian world to face, with confidence in divine benevolence, the difficulties and trials that mankind with experience in the years to come.”

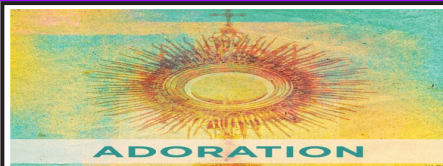

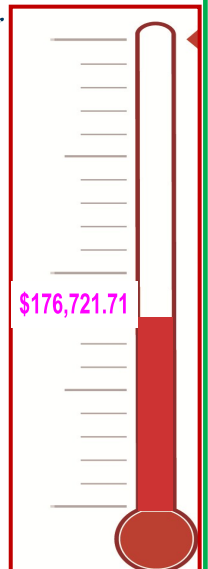

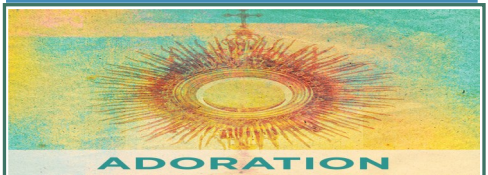

(PRACTICING) CATHOLIC - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Within Thy Wounds

The prayer I love best in the world is the *Anima Christi*. This private, devotional litany of supplication, begins with the phrase "*anima Christi, sanctifica e*" ("soul of Christ, sanctify me") and continues on to appeal individually to each aspect of Our Lord's crucified flesh: "*Body of Christ, save me; blood of Christ, inebriate me; water from Christ's side, wash me; passion of Christ, strengthen me; Oh good Jesus, hear me.*"

Then comes my favorite part: "*within thy wounds hide me.*"

The *Anima Christi* is a prayer traditionally said after receiving Holy Communion. The ancient Celts spoke of *liminal places*, where the veil separating this world from the next is

particularly thin, and I believe the moments immediately following the reception of Holy Communion, when the Host is dissolving on my tongue, create a liminal place. When I am in that place, I am as intimately connected to God as I can be while my heart is still beating.

And when I am there, holding God within me, what are the words that I speak? It's overwhelming to think about. What could possibly be right to say?

There is no right or wrong answer, I suppose. But the best words I can think of are these: "Within thy wounds, Lord, hide me."

There is a reason Christ showed his wounds as he said the words, "Peace be with you." It was not just a means of identifying himself — it was a catechism lesson. *Here*, he was saying. *Here is the peace you will not find anywhere else*

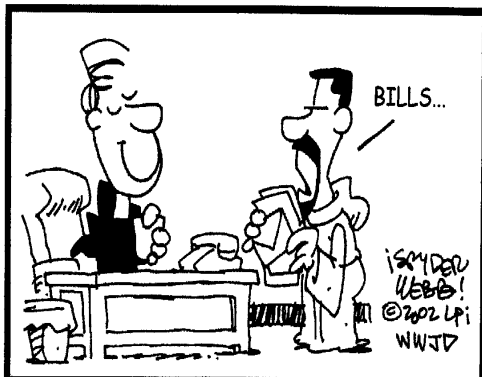

DIocese OF SAN DIEGO

As previously announced by the Diocese in 2022, at the conclusion of a three-year visitation, the Apostolic See (*specifically the then-Congregation for Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life*) by means of a Decree dated 13 May 2022 and approved in forma specifica by Pope Francis, suppressed the religious institute formerly known as the Trinitarians of Mary. With this suppression, the former members of the Trinitarians were automatically dispensed from their vows and are no longer permitted to present themselves as religious. There is no right of appeal, and the Trinitarians have ceased to exist as a religious institute recognized by the Catholic Church.



DIÓCESIS DE SAN DIEGO

Tal como fue anunciado previamente por la Diócesis en 2022, al concluir una visita canónica de tres años, la Sede Apostólica (*específicamente la entonces Congregación para los Institutos de Vida Consagrada y las Sociedades de Vida Apostólica*), mediante un Decreto fechado el 13 de mayo de 2022 y aprobado en *forma specifica* por el Papa Francisco, suprimió el instituto religioso anteriormente conocido como las Trinitarias de María. Con esta supresión, las antiguas miembros de las Trinitarias quedaron automáticamente dispensadas de sus votos y ya no están autorizadas a presentarse como religiosas. No existe derecho de apelación, y las Trinitarias han dejado de existir como instituto religioso reconocido por la Iglesia Católica.
