GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

John 10:1-10

The essential thing on this fourth Sunday of Easter is to know the voice of the Shepherd and to understand how He identifies Himself: *"I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved. They will come in and go out, and find pasture"* (John 10:9). By entering through His gate, we will find everything, and especially, we will learn to listen to Him. Saint Teresa of Avila said: *"To cultivate friendship, by often spending time alone with Him who we know loves us"* (Life 8,5). It is there, in daily prayer, that we discover that He calls each of us by name, that we are not strangers to Him. In those pastures of the Kingdom of God, we have an assigned place to use the gifts God has given us.

In life's experience, there are many thieves who steal innocence and lead many people astray into the abyss. Only the Good Shepherd, who is Jesus, helps us discern the false doors and voices that surround us. The tools that help us recognize Jesus are the Sacraments and the practice of the Commandments, as a way of living Christian morality. Pope Francis, may his memory be a blessing, said: *"The voice of God and that of the tempter, ultimately, speak in different environments: the enemy prefers darkness, falsehood, gossip; on the contrary, the Lord loves sunlight, truth, and sincere transparency. The enemy will tell us: 'Lock yourself in, because no one understands you or listens to you; don't trust anyone!' Goodness, on the contrary, invites us to open ourselves, to be clear, and to trust in God and in others."* Let us ask the Lord for the grace to hear his voice.

WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED
Exaltation of the Cross

Question:
 What is the history behind the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross?

Answer:
 Emperor Constantine’s mother, Helena, is credited with having discovered the true cross around 330. She traveled to the Holy Land and uncovered the places associated with Jesus’ life. Legend has it that Helena uncovered three crosses but was not able to detect the true cross until each of them was laid on a leper. Only one of them cured the leper, proving it to be the true cross. A great church was built at the site, and soon various portions of the cross were sent to other churches as relics to be venerated.


The day after the dedication of the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, September 14, 335, the actual cross was displayed for veneration. Egeria, a women traveler to Jerusalem around the year 386, kept a diary that has survived. She tells of the unique veneration of the wood of the cross that took place on Good Friday, something maintained ritually to this very day.

The Exaltation of the Holy Cross focuses on the gift of love that Jesus manifested by his total gift of self, offered for all. The cross, the ultimate form of capital punishment in its day, has become for us the ultimate symbol of love and triumph over evil and death.

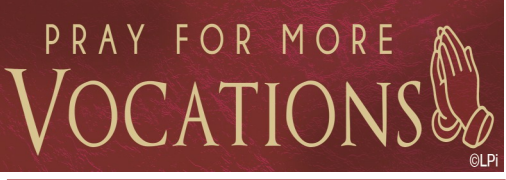

Virtues, Explained! Humility

Humility, Explained!

"If anyone wishes to be first," Christ told the Apostles in the Gospel of Mark, "he must become the last of all and the servant of all." (Mark 9:35).

True humility does not require us to ignore, underestimate or hide our gifts — it merely demands that we use these gifts rightly, with the knowledge that they are from our Creator and meant for His glory, not our own. "Man is a beggar before God," said St. Augustine.

The Blessed Mother is the perfect model of this, and her Magnificat (Luke 1:46-55) is a blueprint for a life lived in joyful humility.

Humility, says the Catechism, is also the key to a fruitful prayer life: "Humility is the foundation of prayer. Only when we humbly acknowledge that 'we do not know how to pray as we ought,' are we ready to receive freely the gift of prayer." (CCC 2559) ©LPi

As previously announced by the Diocese in 2022, at the conclusion of a three-year visitation, the Apostolic See (*specifically the then-Congregation for Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life*) by means of a Decree dated 13 May 2022 and approved in forma specifica by Pope Francis, suppressed the religious institute formerly known as the Trinitarians of Mary. With this suppression, the former members of the Trinitarians were automatically dispensed from their vows and are no longer permitted to present themselves as religious. There is no right of appeal, and the Trinitarians have ceased to exist as a religious institute recognized by the Catholic Church.



DIÓCESIS DE SAN DIEGO

Tal como fue anunciado previamente por la Diócesis en 2022, al concluir una visita canónica de tres años, la Sede Apostólica *específicamente la entonces Congregación para los Institutos de Vida Consagrada y las Sociedades de Vida Apostólica*, mediante un Decreto fechado el 13 de mayo de 2022 y aprobado en forma specifica por el Papa Francisco, suprimió el instituto religioso anteriormente conocido como las Trinitarias de María. Con esta supresión, las antiguas miembros de las Trinitarias quedaron automáticamente dispensadas de sus votos y ya no están autorizadas a presentarse como religiosas. No existe derecho de apelación, y las Trinitarias han dejado de existir como instituto religioso reconocido por la Iglesia Católica.
