GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

John 14: 1-12

Jesus' love for us is so great that He wants us to be where He is. Every word He speaks is filled with hope. He goes to prepare a place for each of us: “And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am” (John 14:3-4). He then continues to show His love by saying, “I am the way, the truth, and the life.” We have no excuse to say that we don't know where to go in our quest to be better. The only Way is Jesus. However, there is also the opportunity to ask, as Thomas and Philip did. Jesus' task is to lead us to the Father; His words give us serenity and hope in the life to come.

It is important to learn, in our daily lives, that the way to the Father is through Jesus. Jesus and the Father are one. So, as baptized Christians, what is our task? From the time of the first Christian communities to the present day, the Church has sought to follow the teachings of Jesus. We have a Father who loves us, and trusting in Him gives us peace, even though there is war and much suffering in the world. We are called to fight for justice and peace, with concrete actions whenever possible and with prayer, as Pope Leo XIV reminds us:

“Truly I tell you, whoever believes in me will do the works I have been doing, and they will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father” (John 14:12)

A friend of mine who had family members belonging to several different religions once told me that there were as many different routes to Heaven as there were to the grocery store.

This was an analogy her family had used to remember that they all sought the same thing — God — even though they were going about the search in different ways.

I've thought a lot about her words in the years since she shared them with me. It's not an untrue analogy — there are a lot of different routes to the grocery store. An infinite number, in fact. There is actually no "right" way to get to the grocery store, because it all depends on where you're starting from and what other errands you have along the way.

And there are a lot of different routes to Heaven — likewise, an infinite number. It all depends on where you're starting from. It all depends on what you have to do along the way.

There it is: the part that matters. *The way.*

Whether we're talking about Heaven or the grocery store as our destination, all routes are not created equal. Some take too long. Some are impassable. Some are hard to navigate. Some are just plain made-up — the glitch of a GPS, the promise of a false prophet. And inevitably, if you take a less-than-ideal route, you will find yourself flagging down a pedestrian, asking, "I'm lost. Which way do I go?"

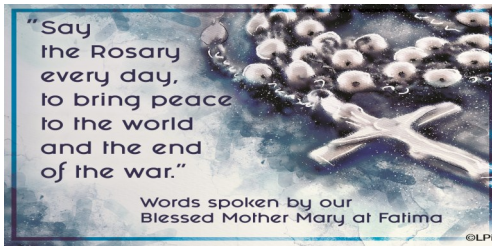
See, you can meander all you want. But in the end, you have to find The Way. And there's only one. Don't worry, though.

DIocese OF SAN DIEGO

As previously announced by the Diocese in 2022, at the conclusion of a three-year visitation, the Apostolic See (*specifically the then-Congregation for Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life*) by means of a Decree dated 13 May 2022 and approved in forma specifica by Pope Francis, suppressed the religious institute formerly known as the Trinitarians of Mary. With this suppression, the former members of the Trinitarians were automatically dispensed from their vows and are no longer permitted to present themselves as religious. There is no right of appeal, and the Trinitarians have ceased to exist as a religious institute recognized by the Catholic Church.



DIóCesis DE SAN DIEGO

Tal como fue anunciado previamente por la Diócesis en 2022, al concluir una visita canónica de tres años, la Sede Apostólica *específicamente la entonces Congregación para los Institutos de Vida Consagrada y las Sociedades de Vida Apostólica*, mediante un Decreto fechado el 13 de mayo de 2022 y aprobado en *forma specifica* por el Papa Francisco, uprimió el instituto religioso anteriormente conocido como las Trinitarias de María. No existe derecho de apelación, y las Trinitarias han dejado de existir como instituto religioso reconocido por la Iglesia Católica.
