GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

John 3:16-18

Glory to the Father, glory to the Son, and glory to the Holy Spirit! “For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life” (John 3:16). After the solemnity of Pentecost, which we celebrated last Sunday, the Church now invites us to celebrate the great mystery of the Most Holy Trinity: a mystery of love and unity.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (number 253) speaks to us of the dogma of the Holy Trinity: The Trinity is one. We do not confess three gods but one God in three persons: “the consubstantial Trinity.” The divine persons do not share the one divinity, but each of them is entirely God: “The Father is the same as the Son, the Son the same as the Father, the Father and the Son the same as the Holy Spirit, that is, one God by nature.” “Each of the three persons is this reality, that is, the divine substance, essence, or nature.” By the grace of baptism, “in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,” we are called to share in the life of the Blessed Trinity: here below, in the darkness of faith, and after death, in eternal light (CCC 265). God is love, and any of us who have experienced true love can understand, through the grace of the Holy Spirit, this great mystery of faith. The essence of the Trinity is to serve and to love; therefore, as Christians, that is what we are called to: to serve and to love.

GOSPEL MEDITATION

John 3:16-18

I was 16 years old on a youth group retreat in the mountains. One night, I opened my heart to the message being proclaimed: that God so loved the world that He sent His Son for us. Later, I lay under the pine trees and looked up at the countless stars. They seemed different. No longer cold, distant balls of chemical reactions, they appeared as an expression of God’s love, as if He were giving those stars directly to me. The truth of God sending His Son changed how I saw the whole universe.

That is what today’s Gospel reveals: **“God so loved the world that he gave his only Son.”** (John 3:16) The universe is not just a whirl of impersonal forces or empty space. At its heart is a gift: the Father eternally giving the Son, not to condemn, but to bring life.

This is not abstract doctrine but deeply personal. God gives His Son for you and me. Each human life is precious enough to be caught up in that eternal gift.

It is in the Mass where we encounter this most directly. In the Word proclaimed, in the assembly gathered, in the priest, and above all in the Eucharist, the Father once again gives His Son. What looks like bread and wine is the drama of the Trinity, laboring to love us here and now.

The Trinity is not a puzzle to solve but the blazing Truth at the center of everything: the Father gives the Son for you and me. Lord, help us to see this more clearly.

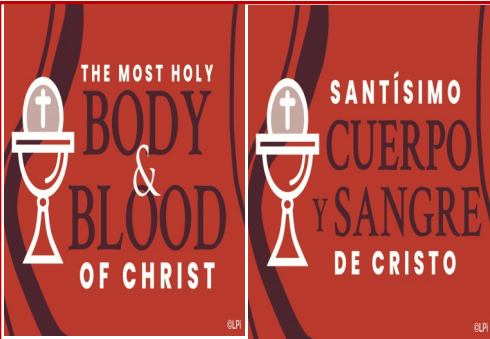

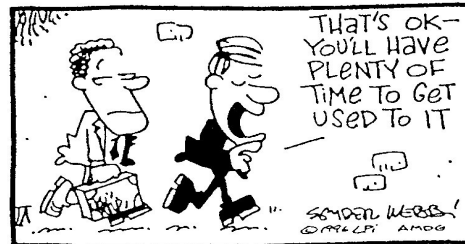

As of April 30, 2026 we have received donations of \$180,901.71 for the Church, Roof, Windows, & Walls Repairs.

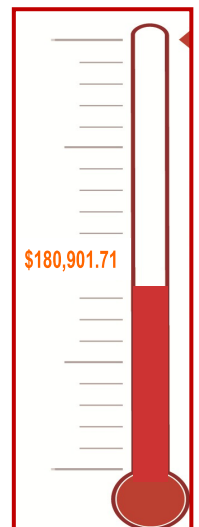

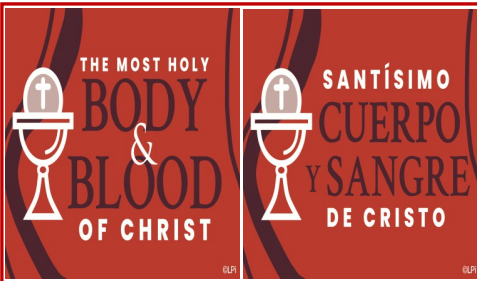

(PRACTICING) CATHOLIC - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

We Bear the Name of the Lord

The name of the Lord is a curiously powerful thing. Say it deliberately, even in a group of people who are not particularly religious, and you'll know what I mean. There is a shift in the mood, a change in the atmosphere. When we utter the name of the Lord, He turns His head.

Once, in confession, I admitted to the sin of using the Lord's name in vain. "When you do that, tell God that you love him," advised the priest, who was wise enough to know that I would repeat this sin at some point. "You've said His name, after all. You have His attention."

We hear the name of the Lord, and we think of what it represents — John 3:16,

salvation history summed up in a neat little sentence, the why and the how and the who of it all laid out before us. The Lord, so slow to anger that He offers us a million chances. The Lord, so rich in kindness and fidelity that He literally gave Himself to us that we might be saved.

But the name of the Lord is more than that. It is not just a symbol, it is an invitation. I think of Moses clutching the commandments, beseeching the Lord: "Come with us. Forgive us. Receive us as your own." The Lord accompanies us down the mountain. We bear the name of the Lord into the world with us wherever we go.

I have to ask myself: do I do that name justice?

DIÓCESIS DE SAN DIEGO



Se les pide a los fieles de la Diócesis de San Diego que actúen con precaución ante un grupo de hombres que se hacen pasar fraudulentamente por sacerdotes y un obispo católico. Afirman ser Misioneros Guadalupanos del Santísimo Sacramento (MGSS) y están ofreciendo sacramentos a familias católicas a cambio de dinero. Se informa al público que cualquier sacramento conferido por estos hombres es inválido e ilícito. Este grupo de hombres-algunos de ellos sacerdotes ordenados, pero ahora reducidos al estado laical-han formado se propia secta; residen en Rosarito, pero no están en comunión con la fe de la Iglesia católica romana. Se han recibido informes sobre la presencia de estos sacerdotes fraudulentos en nuestra diócesis; por ello, se les pide a los fieles contactar a su párroco en caso de tener conocimiento de cualquier incidente. Algunos nombres de los sacerdotes fraudulentos son: Obispo Lauro, Octavio Aguilar Oliveros, Gabriel Figueroa y Raymundo Figueroa Pérez.

Si alguna persona ha sido víctima de fraude en relación con estos sacerdotes, por favor, contacte a las autoridades.

DIocese OF SAN DIEGO



The Faithful of the Diocese of San Diego are asked to exercise caution with a group of men fraudulently posing as Catholic priests and bishops. They claim to be Guadalupean Missionaries of the Most Holy Sacraments (MGSS) and are offering sacraments to Catholic families in exchange for money. The public is advised that any sacraments conferred by these men are invalid and illicit. These groups of men, some of them ordained priests but now laicized, have formed their own sect and reside in Rosarito but not in communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Reports of these fraudulent priests have been sighted in our diocese and the public must contact their priests should you become aware of any incidents. Some of the fraudulent priests names are: Bishop Larro, Octavio Aguilar Oliveros, Gabriel Figueroa, Raymundo Figueroa Pérez.

If anyone is a victim of fraud relating to these priests, please contact the authorities.

The diocese of San Diego treats all allegations of sexual misconduct by clergy or Church personnel seriously and deals with them in a prompt, confidential and thorough manner. DIÓCESIS DE SAN DIEGO
Tal como fue anunciado previamente por la Diócesis en 2022, al Concluir una visita canónica de tres años, la Sede Apostólica *específicamente la entonces Congregación para los Institutos de Vida Consagrada y las Sociedades de Vida Apostólica*), mediante un Decreto fechado el 13 de mayo de 2022 y aprobado en *forma específica* por el Papa Francisco, uprimió el instituto religioso anteriormente conocido como las Trinitarias de María. Con esta supresión, las antiguas miembros de las Trinitarias quedaron automáticamente dispensadas de sus votos y ya no están autorizadas a presentarse como religiosas. No existe derecho de apelación, y las Trinitarias han dejado de existir como instituto religioso reconocido por la Iglesia Católica.

DIocese OF SAN DIEGO
As previously announced by the Diocese in 2022, at the conclusion of a three-year visitation, the Apostolic See (*specifically the then-Congregation for Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life*) by means of a Decree dated 13 May 2022 and approved in *forma específica* by Pope Francis, suppressed the religious institute formerly known as the Trinitarians of Mary. With this suppression, the former members of the Trinitarians were automatically dispensed from their vows and are no longer permitted to present themselves as religious. There is no right of appeal, and the Trinitarians have ceased to exist as a religious institute recognized by the Catholic Church.
