### GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

#### Matthew 10:37-42

In every culture, family is very important. In Jesus' time, family was everything. That's why He makes such a profound comparison: by following Him and becoming His disciple, one leaves behind what is most dear, which is family. Jesus must be the center of everything. "Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. And whoever does not carry their cross and follow me is not worthy of me." (Matthew 10:38).

God is incredibly generous; no one can outdo him in that. That's why the reward for following him is immense: we are adopted sons and daughters of the same Father who loves us. How willing am I to follow Jesus in such a radical way? If I have a special calling to the priesthood or religious life, am I willing to follow it? The answer is personal; every vocation is important, and everything involves sacrifice. But at the same time, everything will be rewarded a hundredfold. God's generosity knows no bounds. Lord, open our hearts to your Word; invite us to share in your friendship, so that we may proclaim your Kingdom of justice and peace, which is so desperately needed in today's society. We want to collaborate with you, even if only from our homes, by being the best fathers and mothers we can be. And from my bed in the terminal phase of my illness, from here, Lord, I say to you with faith: Here I am, count on me.

### Prayer of Thanksgiving for Freedom

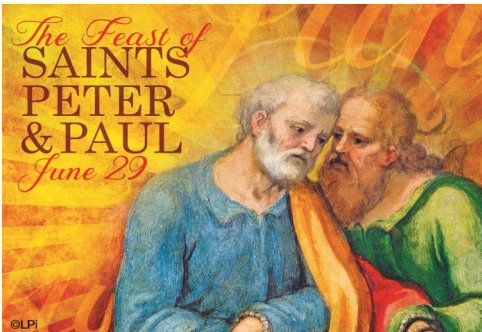

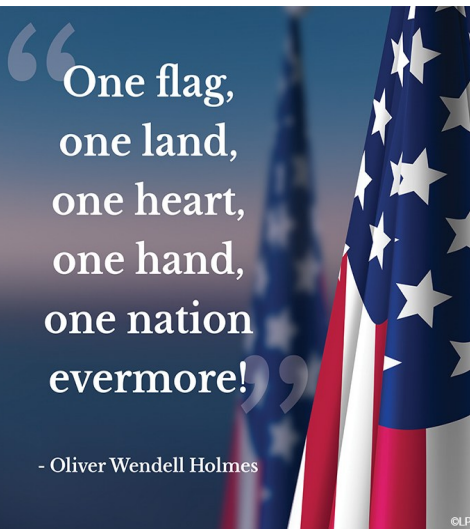

WHY DO WE DO THAT? -  
CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

### Works of Mercy

#### Question:

I've heard of the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy. What are they, and what's the difference?

#### Answer:

As God has shown us mercy, so too are we called to show mercy to those we encounter. We see mercy throughout the Gospels, but the parable in Matthew 25 forms the foundation for the first set of Works of Mercy. This parable of the last judgment shows each person being asked how well they cared for those around them, and being reminded that this care for those in need is care for God Himself. Each person is asked if they have fed the hungry, given drink to the thirsty, clothed the naked, sheltered the stranger, cared for the sick, and visited the imprisoned. These — along with burying the dead — are the Corporal Works of Mercy, as they primarily concern the physical life of a person.

The list of the Spiritual Works of Mercy developed later. These actions of love primarily concern the inner life of a person. They are instructing the ignorant, counseling the doubtful, admonishing sinners, bearing wrongs patiently, forgiving offenses, comforting the afflicted, and praying for both the living and the dead. All of these actions are concrete ways of bringing the love of God into the world.

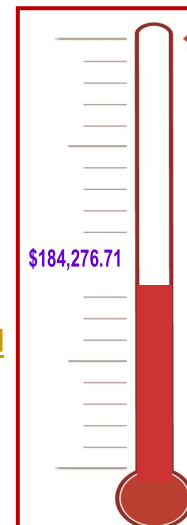

### ¡Discernimiento, Explicado!

Con mayor frecuencia escuchamos el término "discernimiento" cuando un hombre o una mujer considera en oración una vocación religiosa. Este es un contexto útil para pensar en la virtud del discernimiento, que todos los cristianos están llamados a desarrollar, tanto laicos como religiosos.

Cuando una persona escucha un "llamado", no puede simplemente irse — primero debe averiguar de dónde viene el llamado. No basta con tener simplemente la idea de convertirse en sacerdote, hermana, misionero, esposo, o esposa: la idea necesita una buena y exhaustiva verificación de antecedentes. Esto es discernimiento, que "desenmascara la mentira de la tentación, cuyo objetivo parece ser el bien... cuando en realidad su fruto es la muerte", dice el Catecismo. (CCC 2846)

Realizamos esta comprobación de antecedentes de discernimiento sobre nuestros sentimientos, nuestras intenciones y nuestras inclinaciones bajo la guía del Espíritu Santo y mediante un régimen diligente de oración y reflexión. "Los Ejercicios Espirituales de San Ignacio" son muy valorados como una herramienta útil para el discernimiento espiritual. ©LPi

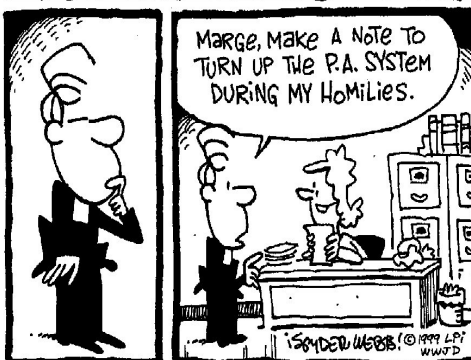

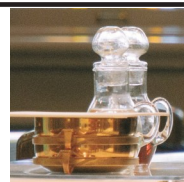

### DIÓCESIS DE SAN DIEGO



Se les pide a los fieles de la Diócesis de San Diego que actúen con precaución ante un grupo de hombres que se hacen pasar fraudulentamente por sacerdotes y un obispo católico. Afirman ser Misioneros Guadalupanos del Santísimo Sacramento (MGSS) y están ofreciendo sacramentos a familias católicas a cambio de dinero. Se informa al público que cualquier sacramento conferido por estos hombres es inválido e ilícito. Este grupo de hombres-algunos de ellos sacerdotes ordenados, pero ahora reducidos al estado laical-han formado se propia secta; residen en Rosarito, pero no están en comunión con la fe de la Iglesia católica romana. Se han recibido informes sobre la presencia de estos sacerdotes fraudulentos en nuestra diócesis; por ello, se les pide a los fieles contactar a su párroco en caso de tener conocimiento de cualquier incidente. Algunos nombres de los sacerdotes fraudulentos son: Obispo Lauro, Octavio Aguilar Oliveros, Gabriel Figueroa y Raymundo Figueroa Pérez.

Si alguna persona ha sido víctima de fraude en relación con estos sacerdotes, por favor, contacte a las autoridades.

### DIocese OF SAN DIEGO



The Faithful of the Diocese of San Diego are asked to exercise caution with a group of men fraudulently posing as Catholic priests and bishops. They claim to be Guadalupean Missionaries of the Most Holy Sacraments (MGSS) and are offering sacraments to Catholic families in exchange for money. The public is advised that any sacraments conferred by these men are invalid and illicit. These groups of men, some of them ordained priests but now laicized, have formed their own sect and reside in Rosarito but not in communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Reports of these fraudulent priests have been sighted in our diocese and the public must contact their priests should you become aware of any incidents. Some of the fraudulent priests names are: Bishop Larro, Octavio Aguilar Oliveros, Gabriel Figueroa, Raymundo Figueroa Pérez.

If anyone is a victim of fraud relating to these priests, please contact the authorities.

### DIÓCESIS DE SAN DIEGO



Tal como fue anunciado previamente por la Diócesis en 2022, al Concluir una visita canónica de tres años, la Sede Apostólica *específicamente la entonces Congregación para los Institutos de Vida Consagrada y las Sociedades de Vida Apostólica*), mediante un Decreto fechado el 13 de mayo de 2022 y aprobado en *forma específica* por el Papa Francisco, uprimió el instituto religioso anteriormente conocido como las Trinitarias de María.

Con esta supresión, las antiguas miembros de las Trinitarias quedaron automáticamente dispensadas de sus votos y ya no están autorizadas a presentarse como religiosas. No existe derecho de apelación, y las Trinitarias han dejado de existir como instituto religioso reconocido por la Iglesia Católica.

### DIocese OF SAN DIEGO



As previously announced by the Diocese in 2022, at the conclusion of a three-year visitation, the Apostolic See (*specifically the then-Congregation for Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life*) by means of a Decree dated 13 May 2022 and approved in *forma específica* by Pope Francis, suppressed the religious institute formerly known as the Trinitarians of Mary. With this suppression, the former members of the Trinitarians were automatically dispensed from their vows and are no longer permitted to present themselves as religious. There is no right of appeal, and the Trinitarians have ceased to exist as a religious institute recognized by the Catholic Church.
