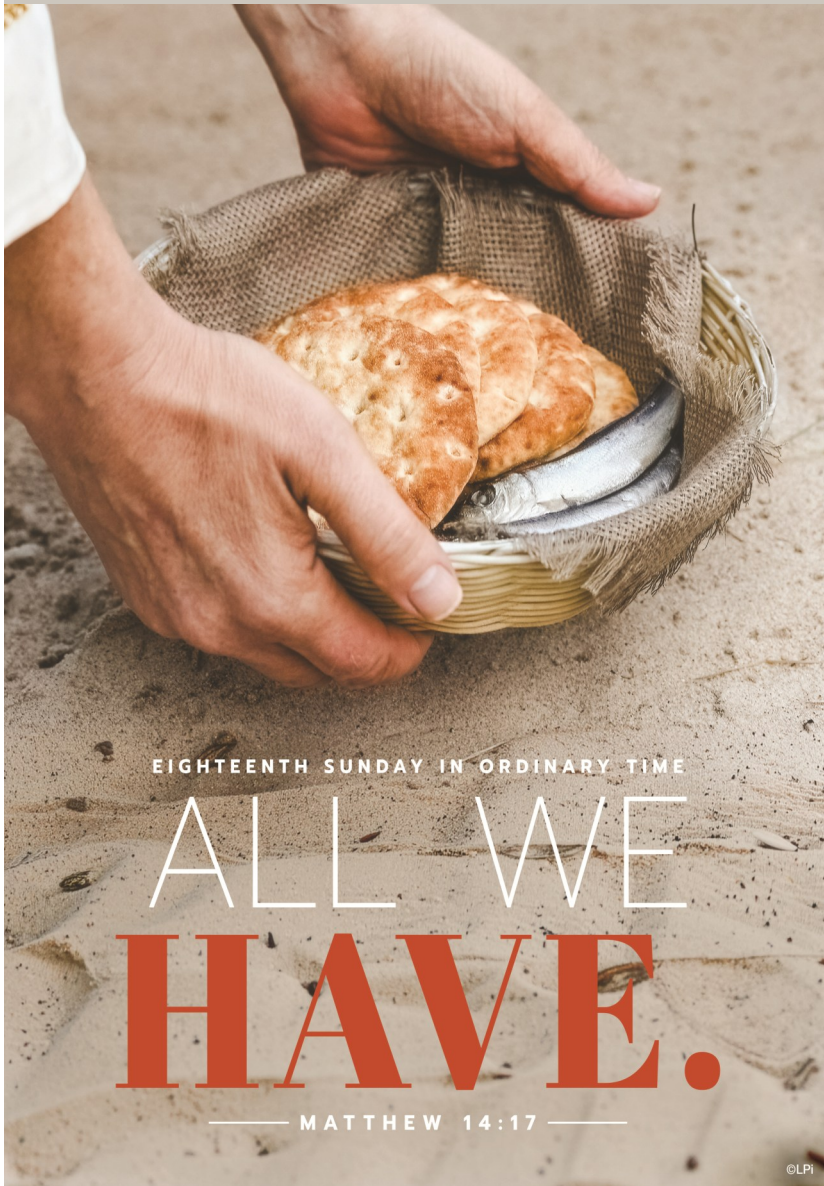

GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

Matthew 14:13-21

In his song, "Lose Yourself," the artist Eminem raps, **"the mood all changed."**

We all know that moment when the mood changes, when life turns from lighthearted to deadly serious. That happens in today's Gospel. Jesus has just heard that John the Baptist, his cousin, forerunner, and friend, has been murdered. As Matthew tells us, **"When Jesus heard of it, he withdrew in a boat to a deserted place by himself."** Until now, he had been teaching in parables and healing quietly. But John's death signals a new phase. The shadow of the Cross begins to fall. Evil shows its teeth.

And how does Jesus respond? Not with rage or despair. He goes to a lonely place to go into deep communion with his Father. From that silence comes action. He feeds the multitude. Out of grief comes generosity. Out of sorrow, life.

This is the rhythm of every disciple's life. When tragedy or violence breaks our hearts, we face a choice. We can react, or we can retreat into prayer — like and with Christ. This is the hidden place where pain becomes compassion and compassion becomes self-gift.

Lord Jesus, when life intensifies, draw me into Your quiet strength. In that hidden place with You and the Father, turn my heartbreak into the bread of love for the world. Amen.

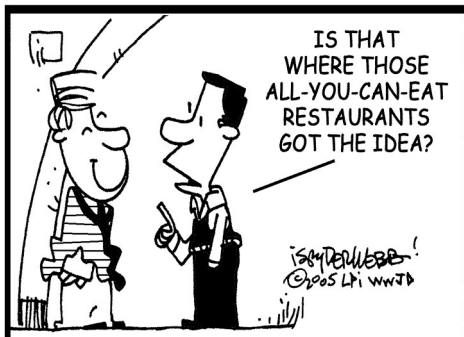
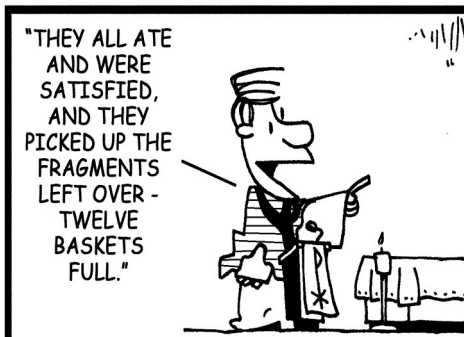

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

The Miracles We Don't See

"Why aren't there miracles anymore?"

I've heard people say this more than once. Usually, it is someone who is a believer in Christ but not a Catholic, because Catholics understand that miracles happen at every Mass, to say nothing of the other miracles the Church recognizes. But even some Catholics often find themselves wondering why it's been so long since God gave us a good show. A good sun-dance in the sky. A good, flashy reason to believe.

I don't know what it looked like when the loaves and the fishes were multiplied. I believe it happened, and I have envisioned it often, but I just can't picture it. Did everyone blink and there was a giant pile of food? Did they just keep finding more? Was it all the same kind of bread, or did Jesus mix it up?

I think the Gospel is deliberately vague on this to test the patience of pathologically nosy people like myself. It's not important what it looked like. If those details mattered, they would be spelled out in Scripture.

How often we find ourselves unsatisfied with the answers God has for us.

I wonder if that's what Christ was thinking when he savored those last few minutes of solitude on the boat, where he had gone to be alone after hearing the crushing news of his cousin's execution. Was he imagining the crowds gathering on shore? Was he contemplating their enormous expectations for God — for him! — and anticipating their disappointment when every wish could not be granted? Maybe. But that's not what the Scripture says.

"His heart was moved with pity," we are told. I think of him looking at them all, so weary and uncertain and hungry. Pity — this is what he felt. Not resentment, exhaustion or frustration. Pity. And his precious heart was moved.

What a miracle. No details, no explanation. No dancing sun. But what a miracle.

Los Milagros que no Vemos

"¿Por qué ya no hay milagros?" He oído a gente decir esto más de una vez. Normalmente, es alguien que cree en Cristo, pero no es católico, porque los católicos entienden que los milagros ocurren en cada Misa, por no hablar de los otros milagros que la Iglesia reconoce. Pero incluso algunos católicos a menudo se preguntan por qué ha pasado tanto tiempo desde que Dios nos dio un buen espectáculo. Un buen baile solar en el cielo. Una buena y llamativa razón para creer. No sé cómo se veía cuando se multiplicaron los panes y los peces. Creo que o currió, y lo he vislumbrado a menudo, pero simplemente no puedo imaginarlo.

¿Parpadearon todos y había un montón enorme de comida? ¿Simplemente seguían encontrando más? ¿Era todo el mismo tipo de pan, o Jesús lo mezcló?

Creo que el Evangelio es deliberadamente vago en esto para poner a prueba la paciencia de personas patológicamente curiosas como yo. No es importante saber como se veía. Si esos detalles importaran, se explicarían en las Escrituras.

Cuantas veces nos encontramos insatisfechos con las respuestas que Dios nos da. Me pregunto si eso era lo que Cristo pensaba cuando saboreaba esos últimos minutos de soledad en el barco, donde había ido a estar solo tras escuchar la devastadora noticia de la ejecución de su primo. ¿Se imaginaba la multitud que se congregaba en la orilla? ¿Estaba contemplando sus enormes expectativas hacia Dios — para él — y anticipando su decepción cuando no se pudieran conceder todos los deseos?

Quizá. Pero eso no es lo que dice la Escritura. "Sintió compasión de ellos", nos dicen. Pienso en él mirándolos a todos, tan cansados, inseguros y hambrientos. Compasión — eso era lo que sentía. No resentimiento, agotamiento o frustración. Compasión. Y su precioso corazón se conmovió. Qué milagro. Sin detalles, sin explicaciones. Sin sol danzante. Pero qué milagro.

DIÓCESIS DE SAN DIEGO



Se les pide a los fieles de la Diócesis de San Diego que actúen con precaución ante un grupo de hombres que se hacen pasar fraudulentamente por sacerdotes y un obispo católico. Afirman ser Misioneros Guadalupeños del Santísimo Sacramento (MGSS) y están ofreciendo sacramentos a familias católicas a cambio de dinero. Se informa al público que cualquier sacramento conferido por estos hombres es inválido e ilícito. Este grupo de hombres-algunos de ellos sacerdotes ordenados, pero ahora reducidos al estado laical-han formado su propia secta; residen en Rosarito, pero no están en comunión con la fe de la Iglesia católica romana. Se han recibido informes sobre la presencia de estos sacerdotes fraudulentos en nuestra diócesis; por ello, se les pide a los fieles contactar a su párroco en caso de tener conocimiento de cualquier incidente. Algunos nombres de los sacerdotes fraudulentos son: Obispo Lauro, Octavio Aguilar Oliveros, Gabriel Figueroa y Raymundo Figueroa Pérez.

Si alguna persona ha sido víctima de fraude en relación con estos sacerdotes, por favor, contacte a las autoridades.

DIOCESE OF SAN DIEGO



The Faithful of the Diocese of San Diego are asked to exercise caution with a group of men fraudulently posing as Catholic priests and bishops. They claim to be Guadalupean Missionaries of the Most Holy Sacraments (MGSS) and are offering sacraments to Catholic families in exchange for money. The public is advised that any sacraments conferred by these men are invalid and illicit. These groups of men, some of them ordained priests but now laicized, have formed their own sect and reside in Rosarito but not in communion with the Roman Catholic Church. Reports of these fraudulent priests have been sighted in our diocese and the public must contact their priests should you become aware of any incidents. Some of the fraudulent priests names are: Bishop Larro, Octavio Aguilar Oliveros, Gabriel Figueroa, Raymundo Figueroa Pérez.

If anyone is a victim of fraud relating to these priests, please contact the authorities.

Reporting Allegations of Sexual Misconduct

The diocese of San Diego treats all allegations of sexual misconduct by clergy or Church personnel seriously and deals with them in a prompt, confidential and thorough manner. To report sexual misconduct by clergy or Church personnel, including abuse, please call Mary Acosta, Victim Assistance Coordinator, (858) 490-8353, email misconduct@sdccatholic.org, or visit www.safeinourdiocese.org.

Situations of recent or ongoing sexual abuse should be reported to local law enforcement.

DIÓCESIS DE SAN DIEGO



Tal como fue anunciado previamente por la Diócesis en 2022, al Concluir una visita canónica de tres años, la Sede Apostólica *específicamente la entonces Congregación para los Institutos de Vida Consagrada y las Sociedades de Vida Apostólica*, mediante un Decreto fechado el 13 de mayo de 2022 y aprobado en forma específica por el Papa Francisco, uprimió el instituto religioso anteriormente conocido como las Trinitarias de María.

Con esta supresión, las antiguas miembros de las Trinitarias quedaron automáticamente dispensadas de sus votos y ya no están autorizadas a presentarse como religiosas. No existe derecho de apelación, y las Trinitarias han dejado de existir como instituto religioso reconocido por la Iglesia Católica.

DIOCESE OF SAN DIEGO



As previously announced by the Diocese in 2022, at the conclusion of a three-year visitation, the Apostolic See (*specifically the then-Congregation for Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life*) by means of a Decree dated 13 May 2022 and approved in forma specifica by Pope Francis, suppressed the religious institute formerly known as the Trinitarians of Mary. With this suppression, the former members of the Trinitarians were automatically dispensed from their vows and are no longer permitted to present themselves as religious. There is no right of appeal, and the Trinitarians have ceased to exist as a religious institute recognized by the Catholic Church.



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
